Outdoor Services Schedule at Mountain Home, Mark your Calendars August 2 and 16 at 10:00am.

A 5 person team was established in May to develop an plan for reopening Mountain Home Church; Larry Johnson has led the team with Diane Peters, Georga Dorsey and Lynelle Eck as members, with Aric as our advisor. In addition Bev Jerden and Darla Stated attended from Sherwood.

They have formalized a plan for each of the two churches to start reopening.

Mountain Home has been approved by Tim Overton-Harris (outgoing Cascadia District Supervisor) to move into Phase 2 for re-opening.
