

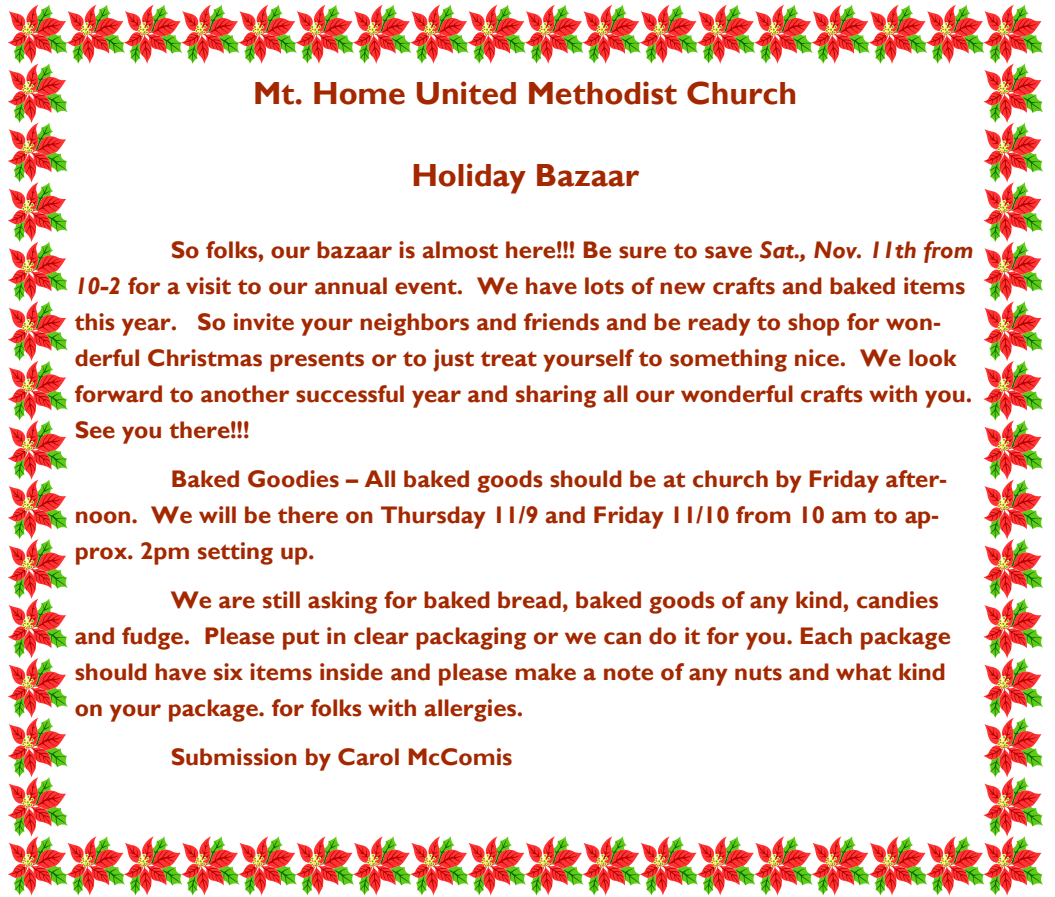

Thank you to Sparrow Dental personnel for the first annual food drive.

We are grateful to be the recipient of 621 lbs. of food! Our shelves and refrigerators are nearly emptied weekly, and this food is so needed.

Our families will have Thanksgiving dinner boxes, sponsored by Countryside Church. WFP will provide the families names as well as turkeys, chicken broth, stuffing etc. donated to us. We are thankful for this mission for 75 families.

We served 201 families with 946 people, a record and spent \$1550 for September.
